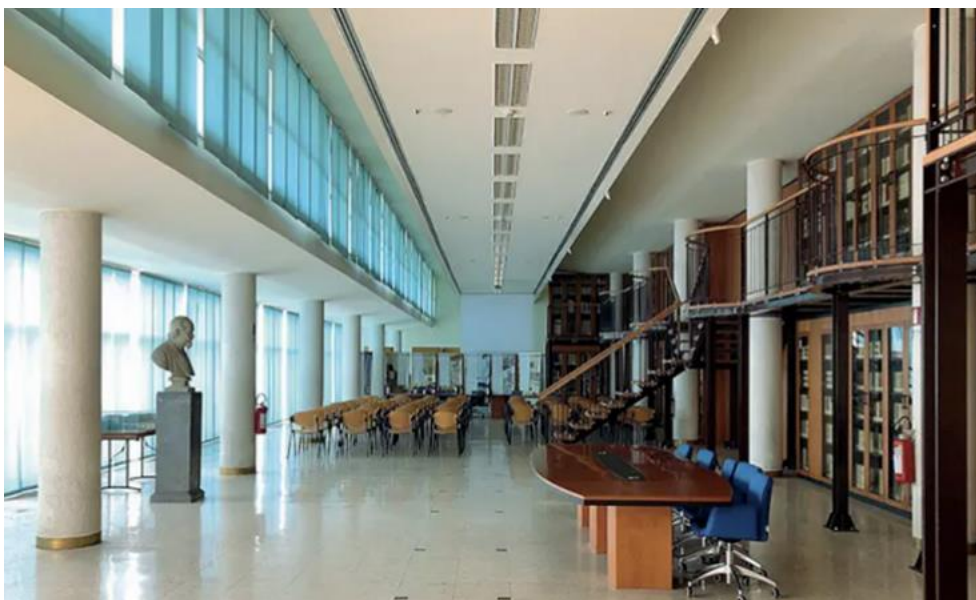

¹The library's collection spans a vast timeframe, encompassing key eras and significant historical events. It houses over 6,000 ancient books and documents related to Engineering and Architecture. This extensive bibliographic archive reflects the ongoing technical and scientific advancements of Neapolitan engineers from the seventeenth century through to the post-World War II period.
